1 1819, April 8

Letter to George Craig from Sir Walter Scott, Abbotsford, accompanying a bill on Constable for £400 and desiring £200 in Edinburgh and the remainder to be credited to his account. He also enquires on what day of the month Paterson's draft on him for £150 will fall due. He writes that he is "gaining strength but slowly" after his severe attack.

2 1820, July 3

Framed letter to George Craig from Sir Walter Scott detailing the arrangements he has made for payment of a bill due to Sanderson and Paterson and sending a bill for £400 on James Ballantyne. Scott will be returning to Abbotsford from Edinburgh on 11th.
