John Boyes (1913-1985) was Emeritus Professor of Dental Surgery of the University of Edinburgh from 1958 to 1977. He qualified LDS RCSEd in 1935, and completed his medical qualification the following year. He spent a year as a school dental surgeon in order to discover more about dental disease in children, and volunteered for active service on a number of occasions, but was refused on the grounds of his hospital responsibilities.

In 1945 he was elected to the Fellowship of The Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, and was appointed to the Newcastle upon Tyne Dental School, where he became sub-dean in 1948, and Director of the Dental Hospital a year later. However, he returned to his home city of Edinburgh in 1958 to assume the Chair of Dental Surgery (he had obtained the Fellowship in Dental Surgery from FRCSEd in 1951).

John Boyes was an outstanding teacher, hugely respected by his students, and he was also a great collector and collator of dental cases, and wrote a number of accounts of historical dental figures. Obituaries were published in the Times, April 30th 1985, Scotsman, April 30th 1985 and British Dental Journal, 1985 Volume159, page 65
