EDINBURGH UNIVERSITY.

THE MEDICAL FACULTY, with the sanction of the SENATUS ACA-DEMICUS, have resolved that the certificates of attendance to be henceforth granted to Students, shall be regulated in the following

Each Professor will ascertain the presence of his Pupils at least twenty-six times in a Course of six months' duration.

- 1. Those Students who shall be found not to have been absent more than twice out of this number, shall be entitled to a Certificate of having attended " very regularly."
- 2. Those who shall not have been absent more than four times, shall be entitled to a Certificate of having attended " regularly."
- 3. Those who shall have been absent more than four times, shall be certified as having "attended, but not regularly."
- 4. Those who shall have been absent twelve or more times, shall not be entitled to any Certificate.
- 5. Half of the above numbers shall be taken to regulate the Certificates for Courses of three months' duration.
- 6. Exceptions shall be admitted in the case of those who may be absent from sickness or other unavoidable causes, the particulars of which must be stated to the Professor in writing. But if any Student shall have been absent for six weeks or upwards, in a Course of six months, or for three weeks in a Course of three months, his case must be transmitted to the Dean of Faculty for the decision of the Faculty.
- 7. Wherever the Student's excuse for absence shall be admitted by the Professor or the Faculty, the Certificate shall bear, that he " attended," and shall state the amount of the irregularity and the nature of the excuse.
