Administrative/Biographical History:

Miss Hannah Harkins was a member of RCSEd staff from 1955-1985, working in an editorial capacity alongside Sir John Bruce, from the establishment of the Journal of The Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh. She undertook a PhD for which she attended palaeography classes and she completed the transcription and translation of the manuscript minutes 1581-1708, creating an account in modern English, of the original old Scots. Miss Harkins also donated a large number of reprints (Boxed at BS H9) and books related to the history of medicine.
