Mr Jamieson died in Edinburgh in June 1956.

In the 1930s Mr Jamieson was surgeon at The Lewis Hospital, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis

In December 1998 the RCSEd was given three old format cine films, by Mr Jamieson's son in law, W. D. Bertram. In 2006, we had them digitised into mpeg and wmf, on cd and in dvd.

Three short films

Film 1

Woman, probably wife, probably in Stornoway, playing in a garden with dogs, then Mr Jamieson joins the scene. **2 mins 2 secs**

Film 2

A child's hip movement being checked by Mr Jamieson then plaster applied to fix hips open **29 sec**

Film 3

Surgical procedure on abdomen **2 mins 33 secs**
