R Leslie Stewart, Sister A Murray Smith, Sister K. Wilson and others. In the Royal Infirmary, [eg 1920s] each surgeon and physician "Chief" had a team of assistants, known as a "Firm". This consisted of an assistant, a resident or non-resident houseman, one or more clinical assistants and a clinical tutor. As well as

being collectively responsible for the patients in their wards, Firms also ran "Cliniques" or classes for medical students at the University and extra-mural school. Clinical medicine and surgery students were generally free to attend cliniques of their choice.
