### **1      1950, December 7**

Letter from R Scott Skirving, Surgeon, Leith Hospital, to Douglas Guthrie, late Surgeon, Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh concerning a set of catheters in his possession, originally made for Robert Liston in Edinburgh. He expresses his desire to present them to the College.

### **2      1951, May 24**

Letter of the same to the same, expressing his pleasure that the College accepts the catheters, and stating that he will have them cleaned, packed and sent off.
